A Note from our PUC Treasurer (Brenda Parker) and F8tS Committee...

When we adopted our 2021 PUC budget, at our Annual Meeting, we budgeted for a yearly revenue of \$101,050 to come from our weekly giving /offerings. This means, from now until the end of 2021, a weekly giving/offering budget of \$2,434.65. Currently we are averaging giving/offerings of \$2,150 per weekwhich means an anticipated shortfall of \$4,839 in what we budgeted for our weekly giving/offerings. This would be in addition to our budgeted anticipated deficit of over \$15,000.

Though this is very concerning, we are very aware that COVID has resulted in increased financial burdens for many of us and we are deeply appreciative of the deep commitment that is reflected in your financial support of our work and ministry. Thank You.

If, however, you are able to prayerfully review your financial support of the work and ministry we share, or if you have a fun fundraising idea that you would be willing to spearhead, that would also be deeply appreciated. Again, Thank You.
